This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 59-230."
 - b. Delete the label statement that the product is a contact allergenic.
 - c. The submitted data will not support the label claim for five months control of horn flies and face flies. The submitted data support 4 months as the duration of efficacy. Thus, change the claim from 5 to 4 months throughout the labeling.

3. The Agency has expedited the processing of this application at your request to prevent having to process additional 24(c) applications for this use pattern. However, be advised that this is the last time we will allow this type of expedite. The Agency discourages the submission of 24(c) applications and section 3 applications for the same use pattern at the same time. We do not have the time nor the resources to expend on simultaneously processing the same action under two different "Sections" of FIFRA. If you have adequate information to support a section 3 registration, then there is no need to seek registration under 24(c) of FIFRA. We are concerned that 24(c) registrations not be used to expedite section 3 registrations but be used for their intended purpose, that is, to control an existing or imminent pest problem for which an appropriately registered pesticide is not sufficiently available.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.




FIGURE 1
Place male button onto pin until it projects through the tip.




FIGURE 2
Dip tag button into disinfectant solution.



For optimum control and to minimize development of insect resistance, use two tags per animal (one in each ear). All animals in the herd should be tagged. Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with Allflex® Tagging System. Tags remain effective up to 5 months. Remove tags in fall.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in cool place away from direct sunlight. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

Pesticide Disposal: Remove tags before slaughter. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
