As with all flea and tick control products, EXspot should be used as part of a control program aimed at reducing flea populations in the dog's environment (bedding, carpets, kennel, yard). Consult your veterinarian or entomologist for program recommendations. If necessary, repeat applications may be made, but do not apply at intervals less than 7 days. Do not use on dogs less than 6 months of age.
