

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. **DO NOT USE ON CATS.** Cats which actively groom or engage in close physical contact with recently treated dogs may be at risk of toxic exposure. Do not use on sick or debilitated dogs. Consult with a veterinarian before using on dogs with known organ dysfunction.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or, if available, by administration of syrup of ipecac. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING OR GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.**

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Adverse Reactions: Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Reported reactions in dogs have included skin sensitivity. Increased itchiness, redness, rash, hair discoloration or hair loss at the application site may occur. Dogs may also show lethargy. Observe the dog following treatment, if sensitivity to EXspot For Dogs occurs, discontinue use and bathe the dog. Seek Veterinary advice.

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read entire label completely before using. DO NOT USE ON CATS. May be toxic if applied to or ingested by cats. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

Exspot for Dogs may be used on puppies as young as 4 weeks of age.

HOW TO APPLY

Hold card in upright position. Point tip of tube cap up and away from user's face and body, then cut along dotted line. Invert card over dog and use point of card to part the hair of dog. Squeeze the tube firmly to apply all of the solution to the dog's skin. Wrap container and put in trash.

Dosage for Dogs Weighing Less Than 33 pounds:

Apply 1 (one) cc of EXspot insecticide solution to the skin of the dog's back between the shoulder blades.

Dosage for Dogs Weighing More Than 33 pounds:

Apply 1 (one) cc of EXspot insecticide solution to the skin of the dog's back between the shoulder blades and apply 1 (one) cc of EXspot insecticide solution to the skin of the dog's back directly in front of the base of the tail.


STORAGE AND DISPOSAL



As with all flea and tick control products, EXspot insecticide should be used as part of a control program aimed at reducing flea populations in the dog's environment (bedding, carpets, kennel, yard). Consult your veterinarian or entomologist for program recommendations. Repeat applications may be made as necessary, but do not apply at intervals less than 7 days. DO NOT USE ON CATS.
