

Place male button onto pin until it projects through the up.




FIGURE 2
Dip tag button into disinfectant solution.



For control of horn flies, attach one tag to each ear of each animal. Tags remain effective up to 5 months. For season-long control of Gulf Coast ticks and face flies and as an aid in control of lice, stable flies, and house flies, attach two tags per animal (one in each ear). Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with Allflex® Tagging System.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in cool place away from direct sunlight.

Pesticide Disposal: Remove tags before slaughter. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
