ized by loss of hair, thickened skin and  
intense itching, caused by the mite *Sar-  
coptes scabiei var canis*. Mix 1 oz. (2  
tbs.) DEL-PHOS™ Sponge-On or Dip  
For Dogs with 1 gal. water. Dip dog until  
skin is wet and allow to shake dry. Do  
not rinse. If no improvement is seen  
within 14 days, consult your veterinar-  
ian. If mange mites reinfest your dog,  
retreatment may be necessary. Fleas  
and Ticks: Mix 1 oz. (2 tbs.) DEL-  
PHOS™ Sponge-On or Dip For Dogs  
with 1 gal. water. Dip or sponge on solu-  
tion until skin is wet. For maximum re-  
sidual control, allow to dry on animal.

Retreat as necessary but not more often  
than every 7 days. Do not treat dogs un-  
der 8 weeks of age. Solution may be  
stored or used for 30 days.
