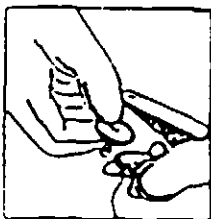


FIGURE 1

the tip.

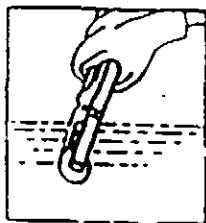


FIGURE 2

solution.

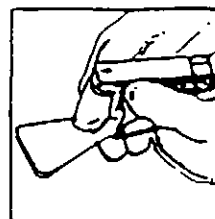


FIGURE 3

(DIRECTIONS FOR USE (continued))

For optimum control and to minimize development of insect resistance, use two tags per animal (one in each ear). All animals in the herd should be tagged. Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with Allflex® Tagging System. Tags remain effective up to five months. Remove tags in fall.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Storage: Store in a cool place away from direct sunlight. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

Pesticide Disposal: Remove tags before slaughter. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of the smoke.
