HOW IT WORKS - GATOR ROACH POWDER is a free flowing, non-caking insecticide powder which, when used according to directions will control Cockroach and other insect infestations as listed. GATOR ROACH POWDER has a "DOUBLE ACTION" - "SLOW BUT SURE" killing power. It acts as a poison when it is eaten and kills by contact when insects walk through the powder. This method is longer lasting and more complete than "short residual" insecticide treatments and without the obnoxious odor of liquid sprays.

HOW & WHERE TO USE - Apply GATOR ROACH POWDER with this "Squeeze Duster" container or sprinkle liberally wherever insects may hide, such as under and behind stoves, refrigerators, dishwasher, washing machines, dryers, sinks and in storage closets. Remove the lower drawers in the bathroom and kitchen cabinets and puff the powder or liberally sprinkle into drawer wells, and into each corner of shelves. Treat any area where insects have been seen, along baseboards and in cracks and crevices, shaking the container occasionally. When larger amounts of powder are needed, spoon size amounts may be taken from the container. For Ants treat their trails. Repeat as needed for control.

After application, brush any visible powder in cracks and crevices. GATOR ROACH POWDER protects for long periods of time when it is left dry and undisturbed. If product is exposed to dampness, remove source of dampness if possible and re-apply to guarantee its powder form. Do not apply to marble stone surfaces.

Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared, or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
