APPLICATION TO POLES

Koppers Woodpecker Repellent is a grease which should be applied in a heavy coat to the pole surface subject to attack, and into checks. A 4" paint brush has been successfully used to apply coats of approximately 1/10 lb. per square foot of pole surface to standing poles. This is a coat approximately 20 mils thick. The grease slowly gives up its repellent to the wood and dries in about 4 to 6 weeks.

Sometimes a very persistent pileated woodpecker will reattack a pole which has been coated. A second coating or spot touch-up has stopped these attacks.

Where deep woodpecker holes are to be filled it is more economical to use the thicker bodied Koppers Woodpecker Hole Filler.
