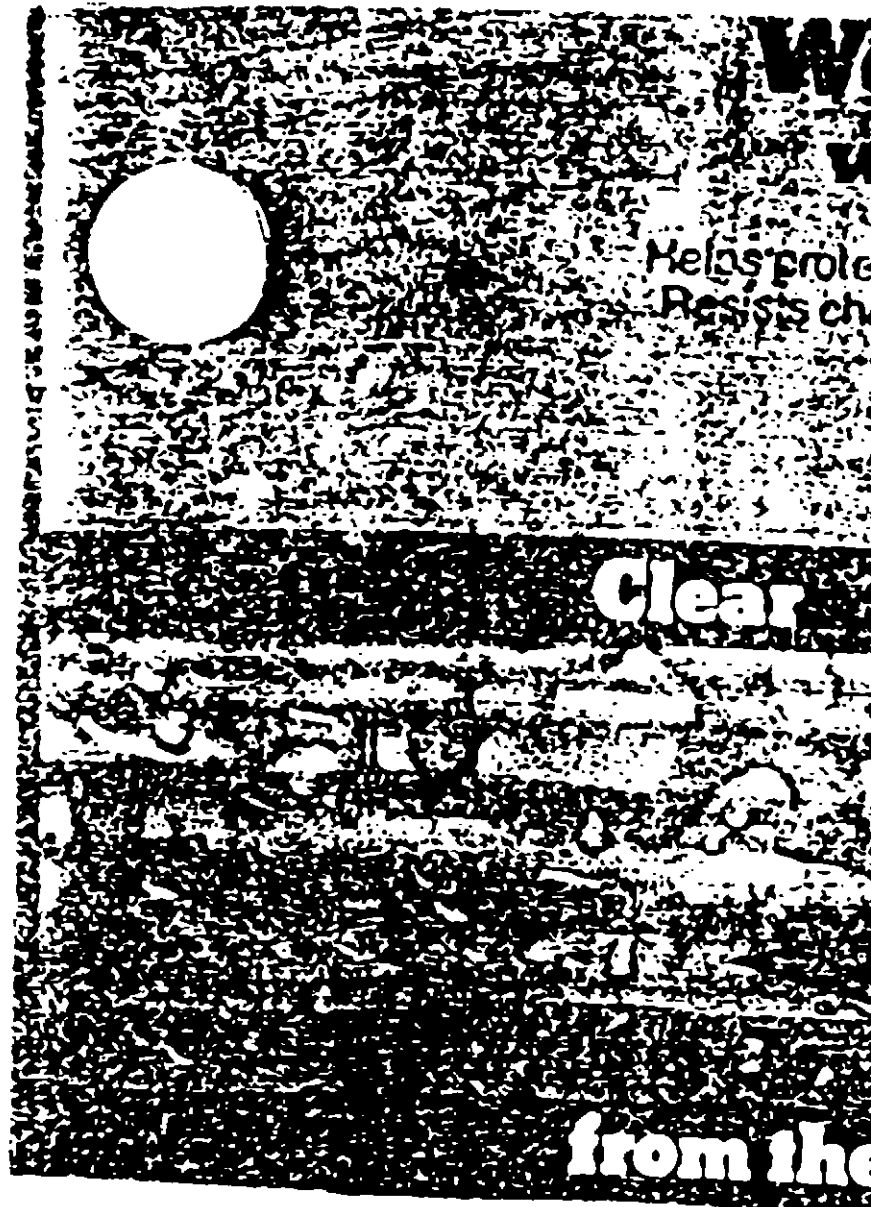

WOLMAN^R WOOD PRESERVATIVE CLEAR LABEL -- DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Like any brush-on preservative Wolman^R Clear cannot provide the long lasting protection that your wood has if it's pressure-treated Wolmanized^R Wood. However, when Wolman^R Clear is applied regularly to non-pressure treated wood it can provide protection against molds, mildew, bacteria, decay and algal growth. Special water repellents also provide protection against moisture movement. Wolman^R Clear is used to treat wood for above ground exposures. It may darken woods such as redwood and cedar, therefore, a test application is recommended to determine desired results. For ground contact use Wolman^R Wood Preservative Green. Wolman^R Green and Clear exceed the Federal specification for water repellency, TT-W-572-B, paragraph 3.7.

All surfaces should be dry and free of mold, mildew, dust, oil, soot, dirt and other contaminants before applying Wolman^R Clear. Use brush, dip or roller; spray application is not recommended. If wood is dipped it should then be layered for best drying results. Allow 24 hours drying time between two coats. Coverage will vary between 150 and 300 square feet per gallon depending on method of application, surface texture and species of wood. Treated surfaces are not recommended to be finished with stain, paint or varnish nor is Wolman^R Clear intended for use over these finishes. Do not apply Wolman^R Clear at temperatures below 50 degrees. Do not thin or mix with other wood preservatives. Clean tools with mineral spirits.

For burlap, duck, rope, nets, textiles: brush on solution allowing several minutes for absorption. Do not use any item treated with this product until the solvents have completely volatilized and they are thoroughly "dry".
