### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**AS A DUST:** Apply at the rate of 2 pounds per 50 feet of row. On flowers and shrubs apply thoroughly to all parts of the plant susceptible to insect attack. Repeat applications as necessary, usually at 7 to 10 day intervals.

**AS A SPRAY:** Use 4 pounds to 25 gallons of water or 1 1/2 cups to 3 gallons of water (12 level tablespoons per gallon) and apply thoroughly to entire plant. 2 quarts to each 50 feet of row in the garden. Repeat applications as necessary. To control Mexican Bean Beetle with either a dust or spray it is very important that the underside of the leaves be covered with insecticide.

### FOR CONTROL OF INSECTS LISTED BELOW VEGETABLE GARDEN

- ASPARAGUS: Asparagus Beetle.
- BEANS: Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leaf Beetle, Spotted and Striped Cucumber Beetles.
- BEETS: Flea Beetles.
- CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS and CAULIFLOWER: Imported Cabbage Worm.
- EGG PLANT: Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle.
- PEAS: Pea Aphid.
- POTATO: Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle, Aphid.
- RADISH: Flea Beetle.
- SPINACH: Flea Beetle.
- TOMATO: Colorado Potato Beetle, Aphid, Flea Beetle.
- TURNIPS: Flea Beetle.

Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

### FLOWERS AND SHRUBS

- CABBAGE LOOPER AND IMPORTED CABBAGE WORM: On Carnation, Chrysanthemum, Geranium and Nasturtium.
- CUCUMBER BEETLES: On Aster, Gladiolus, Canna, Chrysanthemum, Cosmos, Dahlia, Daisy, Rose, Sweet Pea, Zinnia.
- FLEA BEETLE: On Petunia, Primrose, Sunflower, Violet, Stock, Wallflower.
- APHIDS: On Sweet Peas, Aster, Gladiolus, Iris and Sunflower.

### ANIMALS

**DOGS AND CATS: FLEAS**—Dust thoroughly into hair and rub in with the hand. Avoid getting into animal's eyes, nose and mouth. Also thoroughly treat sleeping quarters including bedding.

**CAUTION:** Avoid inhalation of dust and spray mist. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy empty container. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
