Direct KILL-KO HOUSE AND GARDEN PEST KILLER with sweeping motion, holding can 12 to 18 inches away from plant. Do not wet, as the effective formula kills when sprayed lightly. Use spray when air is still, preferably cloudy days and evenings.

For row plants, spray at rate of one foot per second. For heavy growth, it may be necessary to spray from both sides. Use caution on tender plants. Protect plants and delicate flowers, such as:

Flies Gnats Wasps Mosquitoes Flying Moths

Close openings and spray in sweeping motion, keeping spray at least 12 to 18 inches from walls, furniture and fabrics thoroughly misting the room with spray. Leave room closed at least 10 minutes after treatment. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

TO KILL CRAWLING BUGS - Such as:

Roaches Spiders Silverfish Centipedes Ants Water Bugs Carpet Beetles Bedbugs

Spray baseboards, moding, crevices, Ant trails, infested areas of carpets, rugs, mattresses, bed frames and other hiding places.

TO KILL FLEAS: Spray floor areas, sleeping quarters and bedding freely.
