Make the application using hand or power spray equipment or hose attached applicator that will provide thorough and uniform coverage of plants and turf. Repeat as necessary.

Plants	Pests Controlled	Amount ZECTRAN 2E per 1 gal. of water	Remarks
Ornamentals Flowers Shrubs/Vines Turf and Lawns Evergreen	Cutworms, tent caterpillars, European pine shoot moth, birch leaf miner, thrips, red-pine sawfly, fungus and leaf-hoppers	1-2 tablespoons	Spray to wet plants thoroughly. Apply to soil and plants. Do not use on Magnolia, Yucca, cactus, or on plants with flowers. Excessive dosage may cause light injury to plants. See growth on roses, shrubs and petunias.
Turf and Grass Covers	Snails, slug, sod webworm, lawn moth, cutworm, armyworm, millipedes, sowbugs, pillbugs	1-2 tablespoons	Water turf thoroughly. Spray and apply 1 gallon of spray mixture per 100 square feet of area treated. Stake debris under infested plants to kill eggs and slugs included in lawn roots. NOTE: Snails and slugs may feed again after treatment but complete kill may be delayed for two or three days.

Note: 1 & 3 teaspoons per 1 gallon are equivalent to 1 and 1/2 quarts per 100 gallons, respectively.
