HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. May be absorbed by the skin. Avoid contamination of feed or food stuffs. Food utensils such as teaspoons or measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after using with insecticide. **PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:** Mixers and loaders of transplant water containing Lindane must wear the following protective clothing: a light weight protective suit or coveralls; waterproof apron; water resistant hat; unlined, waterproof gloves; unlined, lightweight boots; and goggles or a face shield.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Give victim one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Keep patient prone and warm. There may be an aspiration hazard associated with emesis. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled : Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For protection of roots of newly set plants against wireworms and cutworms, mix and apply as follows:

MIXING: Mix 2 fluid ounces (4 Tablespoons) of Tobacco Transplant Solution in each 50 gallons of transplanting water.

APPLICATION: Apply this mixture at a rate of 1/2 pint per plant or about 250 gallons of the mixture per acre. From tobacco setter water tank, move transplanting water through hose to setter shoe, and dispense onto roots of plant mechanically as setter fingers release plant and plant roots are covered with soil inside setter shoe.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not dip tobacco roots directly into solution as root damage may occur. Do not apply to root crops nor use in soil to be planted to root crops within one year.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the storage and disposal information in accordance with PR Notice 83-3. Lindane is on the RCRA "P" List.
2. Delete "Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur" from the environmental hazards.
3. Add the following use precaution to the label:

This product should be mixed in a well-ventilated area.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
