PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION. May cause allergic skin reactions. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not breathe dust or spray mist. Wear dust mask and rubber gloves and wash thoroughly after handling. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

TOBACCO Wildfire Blue Mold	100 ppm -or- 200 ppm*	Spray or drench when plants are in the two leaf stage or when disease is first reported in the area.	Spray at 5 - 7 day intervals until plants are set into the field or until the disease is no longer a problem, usually 5-6 sprays. Use 5 gallons of spray/100 sq.yds. of plant beds.

*Use 100 ppm as a preventative, 200 ppm if disease has already appeared.

Streptomycin Sulfate may also be used at the 100 ppm rate with Maneb Special, Mancozeb or Zineb at labeled rates to prevent infestations of anthracnose. Weekly sprays may be necessary to prevent infestations.

APPLES & PEARS Fire Blight	100 ppm	20-30% Bloom	Spray trees 3 - 4 days during blossom time. After petal fall, spray every 10-14 days to control twig blight. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest on pears, or 50 days of harvest on apples.
(West Coast Areas)	(60 ppm maximum)
