Harmful or fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. If contact occurs, wash skin and clothing immediately with soap and warm water, and eyes with clean water.

Avoid breathing and working in spray mist or dust.

When spraying overhead, wear a cap with a visor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder is for residual pest control on buildings and structures and for control of ornamental plant and turf pests.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT ON EDIBLE PLANTS.

DO NOT APPLY TO SURFACES WHICH COME INTO CONTACT WITH FOOD.

FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder is intended for dilution with water for application with hand-held, hose-end or power sprayers.

Do not use strainers finer than 100 mesh size.

When using hand sprayers, fill with the desired volume of water, add FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder, close and shake before use to insure proper suspension of the wettable powder. Shake or re-agitate sprayer before use if spraying is interrupted.

When using hose-end sprayers, carefully follow the manufacturer's directions for use in order to obtain the correct amount of pesticide required. FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder should be added after the water and then strongly shaken to insure good suspension.

INDOOR USE

Mix 2 oz. of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder per gallon and apply as a coarse low pressure spray.

Cockroaches: Apply as a spot or crack and crevice spray to areas where the pests hide, such as baseboards, around water pipes and doors and window frames. For heavy infestations, mix 3 oz. of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder in one gallon of water and apply as a coarse low pressure spray.

Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Thoroughly apply spray to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, adjacent cracks and crevices, rugs and floor coverings, and under their edges, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present.

Entire rugs may be treated. Apply the spray evenly (approx. 1 gal./800 ft.²) to rugs and furniture. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Additionally, insure that pets are treated for flea control with an EPA-approved product registered for such use. Do not treat pets or their bedding with bendiocarb. DO NOT PERMIT CHILDREN OR PETS NEAR TREATED SURFACES UNTIL SPRAY HAS DRIED COMPLETELY.

Spiders, Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Ground Beetles, Earwigs, Millipedes, Centipedes and Scorpions: Apply around doors, window frames and other places where these pests may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

Ants: Apply to ant trails, around doors and window frames and other areas where ants enter premises. For carpenter ants, also apply to any nest or infested wood if possible.

Wasps: It is best to treat wasp nests at night when insects are less active and have returned to the nest. Do not wear loose-fitting clothing - take necessary precautions to avoid stings. For best results, carefully spray nest and check one or two days after treatment to insure complete kill, and retreat if necessary. If possible remove and destroy nest to prevent hatching of new insects. For ground nests, carefully spray entrances and surrounding areas. Retreat in one or two days if wasp activity is still present.

OUTDOOR USE

Perimeter Treatment: To help prevent infestation of buildings by ants, brown dog ticks, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, fleas, ground beetles, millipedes, pillbugs, scorpions, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders and wasps:

Mix 2 oz. of product per gallon of water and apply as a residual spray or with a paintbrush to places where pests congregate or can gain entry. Treat the building foundation to a height of 2-3 feet.

Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms and Leafhoppers: Apply 2-4 oz. of product in sufficient water to cover 1000 sq.ft. of turf.

White Grubs: In localized areas of grub infestation, FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder may be applied by watering can. Add 8 oz. of product to 1-2 gallons of water, thoroughly agitate and then apply over 1000sq.ft. of turf. Follow this chemical treatment with thorough irrigation ($\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ inch of water).

Fire Ants: Mix 0.4 oz. or 3 level tablespoons of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder in two gallons of water. Two gallons of mixture are recommended for mounds 8 inches or larger in diameter. Less mixture can be used on smaller mounds; however, thorough penetration of insect galleries must be achieved. Apply a small amount of material around the perimeter of the mound. Apply the remaining volume directly on the mound so as to penetrate insect galleries. A second treatment may be necessary if complete control is not obtained.

Do not disturb the mound prior to application. If possible, make applications after a recent rainfall. For best results apply in cool weather, 65-80^o, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. Pressurized sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

ORNAMENTAL PESTS

Use FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder to control specified pests on non-edible flowers, shrubs and trees.

Important: FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder has demonstrated excellent plant safety, however, all species and varieties have not been tested. When treating large numbers of plants of a single variety, treat a few plants and observe prior to full-scale application.

Caution: This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on plants.

GYPSY MOTH:

Egg Mass Treatment - Mix 2 oz. of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder per 10 gallons of water and apply to egg masses until saturation. Applications can be made up to 3 weeks before Gypsy moth hatch.

Larvae Treatment:

Residual Foliar and Contact Spray: Mix 1.25 oz. of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder per 10 gallons of water and apply to the whole tree (wood and leaves). This will control all larvae stages. An application may be required as frequently as every two weeks to control heavy infestations.

Supplementary Residual Trunk Spray: When large larvae (1-2½") are mobile and seeking resting places and a foliage spray is impractical, mix 1 lb. (.25% a.i.) of FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder per 10 gallons of water and apply to tree trunks until fully saturated, making sure to treat cracks and crevices. A harborage (burlap or tape bands) is recommended to keep the larvae on the treated surface. If required for optimum control in heavily infested areas, applications can be made every two weeks.

Apply FIRE ANT KILLER Wettable Powder to the point of run-off using the recommended rates below:
