## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens under 3 months of age. Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick or debilitated pets.

## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.  
**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
**If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
**If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of EPA.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.**

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days on dogs and will kill ticks for 4 days on dogs and 9 days on cats.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under body. Using a protective mitt or glove, fluff the hair as you spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not, however, over saturate the fur or skin of the animal. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
