Make the following change to the **Confidential Statement of Formula** and submit the corrected form to the Agency for review: The upper and lower *Certified Limits* (columns 14a and 14b) for the formulation component *N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide* are not acceptable. The nominal concentration (typical batch percentage), which is the percentage also declared in the active ingredient statement on the product label, must fall within the *upper and lower certified limits*.
4. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse off. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

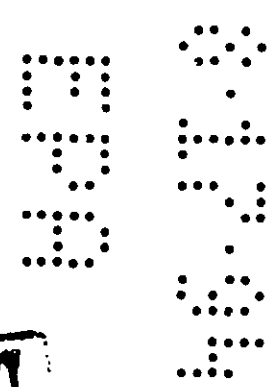
