Shake Rigo's Best Flea & Tick Dip well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

**To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks:** Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not use on animals less than six weeks old.

Rigo's Best Flea & Tick Dip gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash.
