

To kill lice and louse eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray to the point of dampness but not run-off. Spray only those articles and parts of bedding including mattresses and furniture, that cannot be either laundered or dry-cleaned. Do not use on pillowcases, sheets or clothing. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
