

MILLER 15% ZINEB DUST

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Zineb (Zinc ethylene bisdithiocarbamate)*..... 15%

INERT INGREDIENTS:..... 85%

*Metallic zinc equivalent to 3.56%

DIRECTIONS

Apply 15% Zineb Dust before diseases appear and keep plants covered with the dust. Apply the dust every week or more often, to prevent diseases specified. If possible, apply when dew is on the plants to get maximum sticking. Apply enough dust to give a thorough coating of dust on the leaves.

Apply from 8 lbs. to 20 lbs. of dust per acre, beginning with 8 lbs. when plants are small and increasing dosages as plants become larger.

BEANS (SNAP & LIMA): For Control of Downy Mildew, Rust (apply when Rust threatens) and Anthracose (make first application after first blossoms appear): Dust at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do NOT apply within 7 days of harvest.

TOMATOES: For Control of Early & Late Blight, Anthracnose, Stemphylium & Septoria Leaf Spots, & Cladosporium Gray Mold: Start dusting when plants are small and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals throughout the growing season. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

CANTALOUPE, CUCUMBERS, WATERMELON, PUMPKINS, AND SQUASH (SUMMER & WINTER): For Control of Downy Mildew, Alternaria (Marcosporium) Blight, Anthracose, and Gummy Stem Blight: Dust weekly; cover both upper and lower surfaces of leaves. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest to cantaloupes, cucumbers, watermelons and squash.

May cause irritation of nose and throat. Do Not breathe Dust. Avoid contamination of feed, food-stuffs and food utensils. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Keep away from fire and sparks. Keep bag closed and store in dry place. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
