Subject: Amendment - Label Improvement Program Miller Fly Spray EPA Registration No. 72-479 Your Letter Dated June 27, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes !isted below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. You list isoparaftinic petroleum hydrocarbons as a solvent in your Confidential Statement of Formula but list it as "active" on the label. Include it in the total percentage of inert ingredients or submit data justifying its pesticidal activity. Since petroleum hydrocarbons can present an aspiration hazard, add the phrase "Contains petroleum distillates" immediately beneath the ingredient statement.
- b. Due to the high petroleum/low toxicity of your product, we suggest you change the "If swallowed" statement to read, "Call a physician or Folson Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. In addition, you should add the statement under Note to Physicians "Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if material was taken internally."


