STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

ORNAMENTAL PLANTS, FLOWERS, SHRUBS AND SHADE TREES: Rose, Chrysanthemum, Arbor Vitae, Juniper, Azalea, Elm, Oak, Maple, Dogwood, and Pines. (DO NOT USE ON BOSTON IVY).

TO CONTROL: Aphid, Bagworm, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetle, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Mealy Thrips (exposed): Apply 4 pts. per 100 gals. water (4 level teaspoonsful per gal.) when insects or their damage appear. To maintain control for 3 to 4 weeks: Add 1 pt. of Nu-Film-17 per 100 gals. of water (1 teaspoonful per 1 gal.)

RE-ENTRY AND ADDITIONAL APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS FOR AGRICULTURAL CROPS REQUIRING FARMWORKER HAND LABOR TASKS

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly, or through drift, expose workers or other persons. The area treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing, until sprays have dried. Protective clothing means at least a hat or other suitable head covering, a long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers or a coverall type garment (all closely woven fabric covering the body), shoes and socks.

Because certain states may require more restrictive re-entry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

VEGETABLES: Beans, Corn, Pepper, Tomato and Potatoes: To control Potato Beetle, Mexican Bean Beetle, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetle, Armyworms, Tomato Hornworm, and Tomato Fruit Worm: Mix 4 to 6 standard teaspoonsful in each gallon of water. Use 1 gallon of dilute spray to 430 sq. ft. Apply when insects or damage appears and repeat in 7 to 10 days, as necessary. POTATOES: Foliage application only.
