

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always use a good insecticide sprayer designed for the specific application. Spray into space to kill flying insects. Spray surfaces as directed to kill crawling insects. Follow directions for best results.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, TICKS, CENTIPEDES, and certain other crawling insects: Apply directly into infested areas and onto infested surfaces. This drives insects out for contact with the killing mist. Where possible spray heavily all cracks, crevices, under cabinets, sinks, around drains, floors, and any place where these pests crawl, nest or breed. Repeat weekly, or as needed to maintain lasting control.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray along ant trail, into nests, porch landings, building supports, foundations or the sides of the house up to window level. Spray into all openings from which the ants emerge. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS and certain other flying insects: Discharge spray mist into corners, under furniture, and upward in center of rooms. Keep room closed for at least 10 minutes.

TO KILL MOTHS: Brush and air garments. Spray closet walls, floor, thoroughly. Spray clothing completely under lapels, pleats, seams. Keep sprayer a foot away. Repeat in 30 days.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray sheets, blankets, pillows. Spray both sides of mattress liberally, especially tufts and seams. Dismantle bed, spray joints, cracks, etc. Spray walls, baseboards, window trim.

TO KILL POULTRY RED MITES: Around poultry houses and hatcheries, direct a heavy wet spray into all cracks and

crevices and on floors, walls, roasts, nests, and coops. Repeat treatment when observations indicate the need.

FLEAS INFESTING PREMISES can be controlled quickly and effectively by spraying floors and cracks of the infested areas. Fleas lurk in carpets and upholstered furniture. Spray liberally in these areas, as well as in baseboards, wall cracks and sleeping quarters of animals for direct contact with these pests.

STORED PRODUCTS INSECTS, WEEVIL, CADELLE AND CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, FLOUR MOTHS: These can be controlled when in the exposed or accessible stages by the following treatment: Floors, walls and partitions in flour mills, feed mills, empty train bins and box cars should be sprayed with enough solution to wet the surface, paying attention to cracks and crevices where insects may be harbored. Spray old soaked grain heavily to reduce infestation. In addition direct a light spray to hit all exposed ends, sides and tops of stored bags. When reinfestation occurs, repeat the application. Watch for migration periods immediately after or during hot weather. This will materially aid in controlling these pests.

CAUTION: Keep out of direct sunlight. Do not spray around open flame. Spray only when food processing plant is not in operation. Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children.
