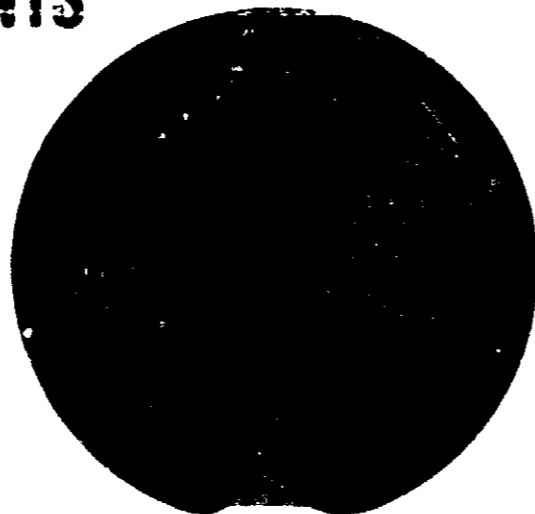

- 2) This spray consists of a water emulsion to avoid burning of plants. TO OBTAIN A MIST SPRAY IT IS THEREFORE ESSENTIAL TO DEPRESS THE BUTTON SHARPLY TO ITS FULLEST EXTENT.
- 3) Spray lightly in short one second bursts both top and underside of foliage. HOLD CAN UPRIGHT. Repeat every 7 days until bugs are gone.

USE ON: African Violets, Philodendrons, Begonias, Boston Ferns, Camellias, Crassulas, Fuchsias, Gardenias, Geraniums, Gloxinias, Ivy, Peperomia, Pothos, Rubber Plants, Wandering Jews, and similar ornamental plants.

Please avoid spraying seedlings, new growth, and fragile plants such as Lantana, Maidenhair Fern, and Cyclamen.

KILLS: Aphids (Plantlice), Mealybugs, Spider Mites, Whitefly, exposed Thrips and certain other bugs hit by spray.
