

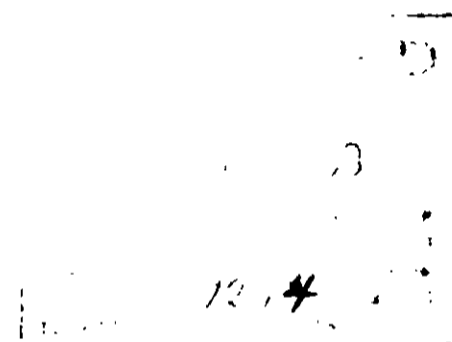

DESCRIPTION

Fen-All (TBA Acid Crystals) is a non-selective granular herbicide for the control of certain undesirable broadleaf weeds and certain species of woody plants. Both foliage and root absorption contribute to plant kill. Fen-All (TBA Acid Crystals) is intended for use on utility, highway, pipe-line, railroad rights of way, and other industrial sites; drainage ditch banks, fencerows; and around farm buildings. Application as directed will result in loss of soil productivity for an extended period.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

How to Apply - Fen-All (TBA Acid Crystals) should be applied directly on the ground surface at base of the weeds, vines or brush. Any satisfactory broadcast type of applicator may be used. Small clumps or individual plants may be treated by hand, directly from package. CAUTION - IF APPLIED BY HAND RUBBER GLOVES SHOULD BE WORN. AVOID CONTACT WITH SKIN.

When to Apply - Best results are obtained if application is made in early Spring, before growth has started. Applications should be made preferably during periods when moderate rainfall can be expected.

Control of Broadleaf Weeds - For control of certain deep-rooted broadleaf weeds such as field bindweed, hairy spurge, Canada thistle, Pigweed, Ragwort, Ranunculus, Blackweed, and climbing blackweed, apply 10 to 20 lbs. "Fen-All" (TBA Acid Crystals) per acre. For small areas, use 1/4 to 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

Mixed Broadleaf Weeds - To control a wide range of perennial and annual broad-leaf weeds for one year or longer, apply 20 to 30 lbs. "Fen-All" (TBA Acid Crystals) per acre. Weeds controlled include the above noxious perennials and others such as dandelion, plantain, dock, dog fennel, ragweed, and wild lettuce. For small areas, use 1/2 to 3/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

Woody Vines - To control certain woody vines such as trumpet vine, honeysuckle, kudzu, and smilax, apply 10 to 20 lbs. "Fen-All" (TBA Acid Crystals) per acre.

Woody Brush - To control certain species such as conifers (spruce, balsam fir, cedar, and pine), wild roses (including Macartney or Cherokee rose), sumac, persimmon, sassafras, black locust, and hackberry use 15-20 lbs. "Fen-All" (TBA Acid Crystals) per acre.

CAUTION

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention.

Apply Fen-All only as specified on this label.

Do not empty any containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed of by punching holes in them and burying with wastes.

DO NOT BURN CONTAINERS
