- State the net contents on the label in terms of the largest U.S. unit present: "1 QT (32 fl. oz.) (946 mL)."
- To the Disposal section add an instruction to rinse the container thoroughly.

In the "If Swallowed" instructions in the Statement of Practical Treatment, it is our opinion that you should indicate ingestion of water as an option because of its availability. you choose to do this, then submit five copies of the revised draft labeling to be stamped.
