## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### **Spraying cows:**

Spray cows in the morning before they go to pasture. Apply 1 to 2 ounces of spray per cow per day evenly applied over the entire animal body. Do not wet the hide with spray, burning can result.

Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

Do not spray on calves under six months of age.

### **CAUTION**

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Keep out of reach of children.

If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention.

In case of contact with skin and eyes flush with plenty of water; for eyes get medical attention. Wash hands, arms and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking.

Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Avoid contamination of milk, milk utensils and feedstuffs by covering or removing from area when spraying cows.

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in safe place away from water supplies.
