Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. For face, dispense on palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not use on infants or toddlers and do not apply to the hands of young children. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

If spilled or over applied, will damage finishes, plastics, and synthetic fabrics except nylon.
