General Information ✓

Simazine - chlorate-borate is a broad spectrum, nonselective, deep-rooted broadleaf and grass weed killer. It is effective when applied before or after weeds emerge. Since simazine - chlorate-borate acts through the roots, its effect on weeds is dependent upon adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone. Excessively dry soil conditions and absence of rainfall may result in poor weed control.

Do not apply to areas underlaid by desirable trees and shrubs or injury may occur. Use only in areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired. ✓

Directions for Use ✓

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. ✓

Apply 1/2 - 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. of soil surface to control annual broadleaf weeds and grasses. ✓

Apply 1 - 2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. of soil surface to control perennial broadleaf weeds and grasses. Where deep-rooted perennial grasses are predominant, use the higher rate. ✓

Use the higher application rates in areas of high rainfall, long growing season, and where extended residual control is desired. ✓

Storage and Disposal ✓

Store in a dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes ~~may be acutely~~ ~~hazardous~~ ~~hazardous~~.
