Application

Hold can upright and spray infested surfaces until wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt tile, rubber, and plastic materials. Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings as damage may occur.

Do not use as a space spray. Do not spray on pets or desirable plants. Remove pets from area, and cover fish bowls before spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INDOORS*

Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Springtails, Spiders, Crickets, Earwigs: Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, ant trails, and other localized areas infested with insects. Spray window and door frames where ants enter. Treat inaccessible areas, voids around water pipes, cracks, and crevices along baseboard moldings. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet beetles: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks, and infested areas of shelving in closets. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT apply directly to carpets or floor coverings as damage may occur.

Brown dog ticks: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and sleeping quarters of pets, and tocalized areas of ficors and floor coverings. Rupeat as necessary Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals. DO NOt apply directly to carpets or floor coverings because damage may occur.

Spiders: Apply spray around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl

Surfaces behind and beneath cabinets: Roaches, ants, silverfish—as a supplement to good housekeeping, spray surfaces behind and beneau cabinets where insects tend to hide. Suray until wet. Remove all food before spraying. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

*DO NOT USE IN EDIBLE PRODUCTS AREAS OF FOOD PRO-CESSING PLANTS, RESTAURANTS OR OTHER AREAS WHERE FOOD IS COMMERCIALLY PREPARED OR PROCESSED. DO NOT USE IN SERVING AREAS WHILE FOOD IS EXPOSED.

OUTDOORS

Flies. Mosquitoes. Wasps. Flying moths: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window flames or wherever these insects may enter. Treat dark corners and localized resting areas, under eaves, on porches, around patios, and garages. Repeat as necessary. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

Chiggers. Ants, crown dog ticks, Clover mites: For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas where there is no regetation to be used for food or feed, spray infested areas. Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

Porches, Patios. Garages, and other areas around the house where insects hide and congregate: To help keep flies, mosquitoes, wasps, and flying moths from enterini, the house, treat outdoor areas where these insects congregate. This treatment can be an effective addition to total pesi control.

Storage and Disposal

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humane and Domestic Animals CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid inhalation and skin contact; wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Remove pets from area and cover fish bowis before spraying. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces have dried.

Statement of Fractical Treatment

If swallowed, call a physician immediately, DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing

If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated.

if on skin, wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly,

If in eyes, rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician: This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. This product contains xylene range aromatic solvent, which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if product was taken internally.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from lire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
