

Controls

Cockroaches (waterbugs), ants, firebrats, silverfish, brown dog ticks, springtails, spiders, crickets, earwigs, sowbugs (pillbugs), carpet beetles

Precautions: (1) Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray; take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. (2) Use only in well-ventilated areas. (3) Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. (4) Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before application.
