Cotton

Spider mites, boll weevil, bollworm: Primarily for spider mite control - Apply 4 pints per acre with aerial or ground equipment when mite foliar feeding symptoms are present (feeding symptoms are red and yellow speckling of the leaves). Make aerial applications in a minimum of 3 gallons of water per acre and ground applications in a minimum of 10 gallons of water. Repeat applications can be made if necessary at 5 - 7 day intervals. If boll weevil and bollworms are present at time of application for spider mites, they will be controlled.

- Note:
- (1) Do not make more than 3 applications per year.
 - (2) Do not apply after the bolls begin to open, or apply within 60 days of harvest.
 - (3) Do not graze treated cotton plants or feed gin waste to livestock.
