Subject: Amendment - Update Label
Stabilized Diazinon MG-8
EPA Registration No. 100-524
Your Application Dated February 16, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add the common name Diazinon in front of the formula name, which should be enclosed in brackets.
2. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, and the heading "Storage and Disposal."
3. Delete "or spray mist" from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section since this is not an end-use spray product.
4. Add "and before smoking or eating" to "Wash thoroughly after handling."
5. Add "or convulsing" between "unconscious" and "person" in the "If Swallowed" advice, since this is a possible effect of organophosphate poisoning.
6. The preferred first statement of the "If Swallowed" advice would be "Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately." This would supersede "Get medical attention immediately" appearing in the middle of the proposed text.

7. The Agency would prefer the following Note to Physician advice.

Note to Physician: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

8. Add "U. S." before "Environmental Protection Agency."

9. Capitalize the "F" of "Federal law" in the misuse statement.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
