The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Submit/cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under PTEPA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling within 30 days of the date printed on this letter.
- 3. Hake label revisions specified below:
 - a. On page 4 of subject labeling, please revise the statement "If this product is used to formulate lawn care products..." to read "If this product is used to formulate lawn care or turf products the following restrictions do not apply"
 - b. On page 4 of subject labeling please include the following under the list of restrictions:


