Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) for Methidathion, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Generic data requirements that have been identified in the RED as confirmatory data for the active ingredient contained in the subject product will continue to be tracked and assessed in the Agency's continual reassessment of pesticides.

The labeling for the subject product submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided you submit one (1) copy of the final printed label incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this Notice must bear the new revised label.

If swallowed	 Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

Contains an organophosphate (methidathion) that inhibits cholinesterase. Consider taking venous blood for determination of blood cholinesterase activity (use heparin tube). Administer atropine sulfate, either by intramuscular or intravenous injection, dependant on severity of poisoning. Cyanosed patients must be given oxygen first; atropine must not be given to anoxic patients. Oximes such as 2-PAM are also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Avoid the use of respiratory depressants, e.g. barbiturates and opiates. Carefully monitor patient because continued absorption of the poison may occur resulting in fatal relapse after initial improvement.
