# Insecticide for control of certain insects on certain vegetables, fruits, ornamentals

## Directions for Use

Soil Application: To control cutworms and wireworms prior to planting of the following vegetables:

Lettuce

Melons

Onions

Par<u>snics</u>

Beans Broccoli Cabbage Carrots Cauliflower
Corn
Cucumbers

Endive

Peas Peppers Potatoes Spinach

Squash Tomatoes

Apply evenly as a broadcast treatment over the surface of the soil. Immediately after spreading, mix thoroughly with the soil to a depth of 6-8 inches. Apply ½ lb. per 225 sq. ft.

Foliage Application: Apply dust at first signs of insects. Repeat as necessary. For best results, dust in early morning or late evening when temperature is lower and a ris still. Apply dust so that all parts of plants are contacted, especially upper and lower leaf surfaces. Number in parentheses, ( ), indicates days required between last application and harvest.






