Dear Ms. Moore:

The application referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA § 3(c)(7)(B) subject to the following conditions:

1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration review of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Any end-use product(s) containing uses on snap bean and/or dill must require a 48-hour reentry interval (REI) for hand-set irrigation activity in order to mitigate potential post-application worker exposure risk. Results from a dislodgeable foliar residue (DFR) study (Guideline 875.2100) may refine the post-application assessment and revise this requirement.
3. Any end-use product(s) containing uses on snap bean and/or dill must require the use of waterproof or chemical-resistant gloves for mixing and loading liquid formulations for chemigation applications to protect occupational handler exposure risk. Prometryn products typically require the use of protective gloves for all applicators and handlers.
4. If you fail to satisfy these data requirements, EPA will consider appropriate regulatory action, including, among other things, cancellation under FIFRA § 6(e).


