Algaetrol requires no special equipment for treating water. May be added directly to the pool in any spot or added to the water circulation equipment, preferably after the filters have been back washed.

Corrosive. Causes eye irritation and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Use goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. If in eyes, flush with water. If swallowed, avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Initial Application: Apply 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof.
Continued Application: One quart Algaetrol per 10,000 gallons of water every 30 days, or as needed to maintain 2 ppm. in the water.
Booster Application: One quart Algaetrol per 10,000 gallons of water once a month, or when there is a heavy infestation.
