The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

1. Change the second "Pesticide Disposal" subheading under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL to "Container Disposal."

Please note that the uses for bananas (including plantains), and noncrop areas have been canceled by means of voluntary cancellation. This cancellation goes into effect on the date of this letter.

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

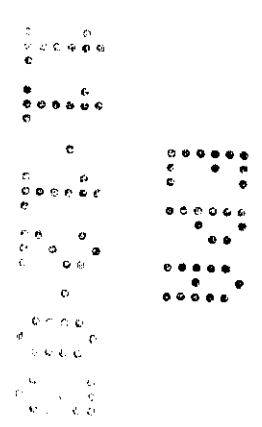

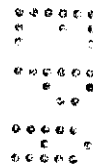
