GENERAL INFORMATION

TANDEX 4 GRANULES is an effective general herbicide for the control of many annual and perennial weeds, including grasses and certain types of brush and trees. Apply to non-cropland areas; i. e., railroad and pipeline right-of-ways, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, storage areas and industrial plant sites. Effects are slow to appear and may not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zones by moisture. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS

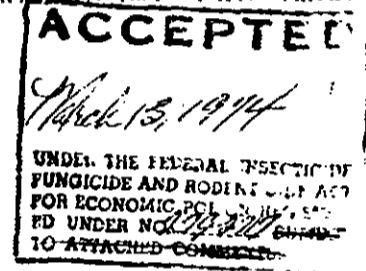

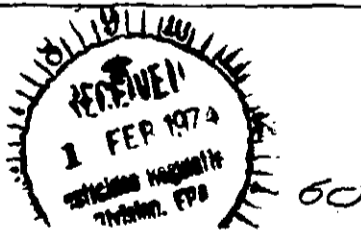
