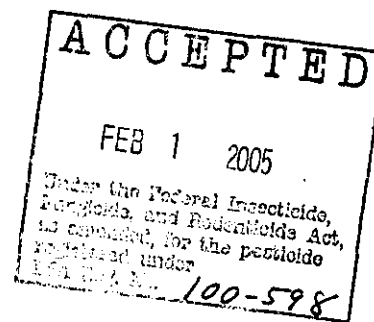

<p>Contains profenofos, an organophosphate that inhibits cholinesterase. Consider taking venous blood for determination of blood cholinesterase activity (use heparin tube). Administer atropine sulfate, either by intramuscular or intravenous injection, dependant on severity of poisoning. Oximes such as 2-PAM are also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Avoid the use of respiratory depressants, e.g. barbiturates and opiates.</p>
