Supplemental Labeling for Sod and Turf Uses

Dear Mr. Campbell:

The supplemental labeling referred to above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment:

- 1) Add the following restrictions to the Precautions section of TURFGRASS FOR SOD (FL ONLY) section:
 - a. Do not exceed 4.4 lbs Princep Caliber 90 per acre (4 lbs ai/A) per application
 - b. Do not apply more than 2 applications per year
 - c. Do not exceed 6.6 lbs Princep Caliber 90 per acre (6 lbs ai/A) per calendar year.

- 2) Add "**per application**" after "(2.2 lbs/A of Princep Caliber 90)" in the restriction "Do not apply more than 2 lbs a.i/A (2.2 lbs/A of Princep Caliber 90) and not more than 2 applications per year" in the section TURFGRASSES FOR SOD (IN STATES EXCEPT FL). Also add the following restriction directly following: "Do not exceed 3.3 lbs/A Princep Caliber 90 (3 lbs ai/A) per calendar year."


- 3) Add the following restrictions to the Precautions section of TURFGRASS FOR FAIRWAYS, LAWNS, AND SIMILAR AREAS:
 - a. 9) Do not exceed 2 lbs a.i/A (2.2 lbs/A of Princep Caliber 90) per application
 - b. 10) Do not exceed 3.3 lbs/A Princep Caliber 90 (3 lbs ai/A) per calendar year.
 - c. 11) Maximum of 2 applications per year

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TURFGRASS FOR SOD (FL ONLY)

St. Augustinegrass, Bermudagrass, Centipedegrass, and Zoysiagrass

Apply 2.2-4.4 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90, according to soil texture as indicated below. This product must be watered in immediately after application if applied at a rate greater than 2 lbs. a.i./A (2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90).

Muck or peat	4.4 lbs.	Old beds	Within 2 days after lifting of sod
		New beds	3-4 days after sprigging or plugging
Sandy soil	2.2 lbs.	Old beds	Within 2 days after lifting of sod
		New beds	7-10 days after sprigging or plugging

If weeds regrow, apply an additional 2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 on much or peat, or 1.1 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 on sandy soil.

Precautions: To avoid crop injury, (1) Do not apply within 30 days prior to cutting or lifting. (2) Do not apply in combination with surfactants or other spray additives. (3) Use only on turfgrass reasonably free of infestations of insects, nematodes, and diseases. (4) On newly sprigged turfgrass, temporary slowing of growth may follow application.

Note: Do not graze or feed turf clippings to animals or illegal residues may result.

TURFGRASSES FOR SOD (IN STATES EXCEPT FL)

Apply 1.1.-2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90.

Do not apply to established beds within 2 days after lifting of sod. Do not apply to new beds before 7-10 days after sprigging or plugging.

Do not apply more than 2 lbs. a.i./A (2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90) and not more than two applications per calendar year.

Precautions: On newly sprigged turfgrass, hybrid bermudagrass, nondormant bermudagrass or nondormant zoysiagrass, temporary slowing of growth and yellowing may occur following application. To avoid turf injury, (1) use only on turfgrass reasonably free of infestations of insects, nematodes, and diseases. (2) Do not use

north of NC (except in the VA Coastal Plains) or on soils with a pH above 7.8. (3) Do not use on muck or alkaline soils. (3) Do not apply over the rooting area of trees or ornamentals not listed on this label. (5) Do not seed or overseed with desirable turfgrass within 4 months before or 6 months after treatment. (6) Do not apply this product to newly seeded grasses until they have overwintered and have a well-developed rhizome system. (7) Do not exceed 2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 within 12 months of seeding grasses.

Note: Do not graze or feed turf clippings to animals or illegal residues may result.

TURFGRASS FOR FAIRWAYS, LAWNS, AND SIMILAR AREAS

Bermudagrass, Centipedegrass, St. Augustinegrass, and Zoysiagrass

Apply Princep Caliber 90 after September 1 (after October 1 for annual bluegrass) before emergence of winter annual weeds. Fall applications of Princep Caliber 90 will control annual bluegrass, burclover, lawn burweed, common and mouseear chickweed, corn speedwell, henbit, hop clover, spurweed, and parsley-piert. Princep Caliber 90 will also control these weeds soon after emergence. For control of summer annual weeds listed in the **General Information** section of this label, apply Princep Caliber 90 in late winter before the weeds emerge. Apply in a minimum of 15 gals. of water per acre.

Irrigate with 1/2 inch of water if rainfall does not occur within 10 days after preemergence treatment.

Where annual bluegrass is the major weed, use 1.1 lbs. of Princep Caliber 90 per acre (0.4 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft.). Use 1.1-2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 (0.4-0.8 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft.) for control of other weeds. However, do not exceed 1.1 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 per treatment on newly sprigged turfgrass or on hybrid bermudagrass.

For control of summer annuals, which emerge after the initial application, apply an additional 1.1 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 at least 30 days after the initial application, but not after June 1. However, do not make more than 2 applications per calendar year.

Precautions: On newly sprigged turfgrass, hybrid bermudagrass, nondormant bermudagrass or nondormant zoysiagrass, temporary slowing of growth and yellowing may occur following application. To avoid turf injury, (1) use only on turf grass reasonably free of infestations of insects, nematodes, and diseases. (2) Do not use on golf greens. (3) Do not use north of NC (except in the VA Coastal Plains) or on soils with a pH above 7.8. (4) Do not use on muck or alkaline soils. (5) Do not apply over the rooting area of trees or ornamentals not listed on this label. (6) Do not seed or overseed with desirable turfgrass within 4 months before or 6 months after treatment. (7) Do not apply this product to newly seeded grasses until they have overwintered and have a well-developed rhizome system. (8) Do not exceed 2.2 lbs./A of Princep Caliber 90 within 12 months of seeding grasses.
