

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORMULATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into an insecticide for the following use(s): leafy vegetables; peppers; cucurbits; Chinese mustard (FL only); Chinese cabbage (FL only); chrysanthemums; layer and breeder chicken operations; landscape ornamentals; container-grown ornamentals; greenhouse, lath, and shade house grown ornamental crops; and interiorscapes.

For use only by authorized formulators. Refer to appropriate technical bulletins furnished by Syngenta for instructions for formulation and other information.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal practices.

#### Pesticide
