Only for formulation of end-use insecticides for the following use(s):

- **Crops:**
 - Abyssinian cabbage, *Brassica* leafy vegetables, bulb vegetables, cucurbits, dry beans, Hanover salad, leafy vegetables, tomatoes, peppers; seakale cabbage, and turnip greens
- **Ornamentals:**
 - chrysanthemums; container-grown ornamentals; greenhouse, lathhouse, and shade house-grown ornamental crops; interiorscapes and landscape ornamentals
- **Other**
 - layer and breeder chicken operations, mushroom compost

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
