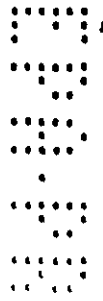

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Note to Physician: Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. If swallowed and gastric lavage is not immediately available, induce vomiting taking care to avoid inhalation of stomach contents into lungs.

Environmental Hazards
