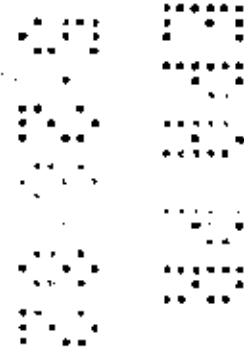

Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spot Treatment

To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns and other recreational areas, apply 1/2 cup over, and 2 ft. around, each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Reapply as necessary. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

Note: For best results, apply in cool weather, 65-80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Storage and Disposal

Do not store near food or feed products. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dust and contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry. Avoid contamination of food and feed. In the event of an emergency, call (919) 292-7100 day or night.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If swallowed, call a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes, flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation develops or persists.

Note to Physician: If symptoms of cholinergic poisoning occur, administer atropine therapeutically.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. / Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries (except for effluence from treated watercress beds). Do not apply to water that will be used for recreational purposes and human and livestock consumption. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where fish, shrimp, crab, and other aquatic life are important resources. This product must not be used in areas where impact on threatened endangered species is likely. Contact your State Fish and Game Agency for information pertaining to areas having threatened endangered species. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Caution section to something similar to the following:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through  
the skin. Do not store near food or feed  
products. Avoid breathing dust and contact with  
eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly after  
handling and before eating or smoking. Keep  
children and pets off treated areas until this  
material is washed into soil and grass is dry.  
Food utensils such as teaspoons and measuring  
cups should not be used for food purposes and use  
with pesticides. In the event of an emergency,  
call (919) 292-7100 day or night.

- e. The Environmental Hazards Section should be revised as it tends  
to reflect agricultural use and your product is being sold for  
"fire set in lawns and recreational areas." Something similar to

description of final printed labeling.

subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for  
shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
