Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spot Treatment

To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns and other recreational areas, apply 1/2 cup over, and 2 ft. around, each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Reapply as necessary. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

Note: For best results, apply in cool weather, 65-80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Storage and Disposal

Do not store near food or feed products. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Do not store near food or feed products. Avoid breathing dust and contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Statement of Practical Treatment

- If swallowed:** Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation develops or persists.

Note to Physician: If symptoms of cholinergic poisoning occur, administer atropine therapeutically.

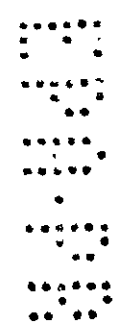
