

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. Keep away from fire and sparks. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not allow to become wet or overheated in storage. decomposition, impaired activity, or fire may result. Keep container closed when not in use.

Pallets of containers should not be stacked more than three high. Provide access aisle for each two rows. Decomposition produces a foul odor, if observed, check for hot containers and remove immediately to open areas for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of it in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

D-z-n diazinon 1/28 MF
EPA Reg. No. 100-648
Your submission dated November 14, 1988

Dear Ms. Bussey:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with a registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided the following revisions are made prior to release for shipment:

- 1) The active ingredient should be declared as follows:

Diazinon [O,O-Diethyl O-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate]

- 2) Add "Recommended for commercial/industrial use only" to the top of the front panel, since this product is labeled for use in food areas of food/feed handling establishments. This is not a homeowner use pattern. Alternatively, you may elect to delete the directions for use in food areas of food/feed handling establishments. Also, is the ready-to-use container capable of delivering the required pin stream, by nozzle selection or use of an attached injection tube, for crack and crevice application. No mention is made of an injection tube with the container. Is one provided?
- 3) Replace "Nonfood/feed" with "Nonfood/nonfeed" in the heading and text relating to use in nonfood/nonfeed areas of food and feed handling establishments.
- 4) In the "House Foundation Treatment" directions, revise the last sentence to read: "Do not spray lawns, desirable plants, or shrubbery because injury may occur."

- 5) In the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" add: "Remove pets from area, and cover fish bowls before spraying." after "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."
- 6) Delete "Repeat until vomit fluid is clear" from the "If swallowed" advice in the "Statement of Practical Treatment", if, as implied by your current text, the solvent presents an aspiration hazard, since repeating the vomiting procedure could potentially increase that risk. Also, revise the last sentence of this same section to read: "Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing."
- 7) Revise the "Note to Physician" text to read as follows:

This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. The solvent in this product may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit five (5) copies of the revised amended label prior to release for shipment.





General Information

This product is a ready-to-use microemulsion containing diazinon and is packaged in this ready-to-use container. Hold container upright and spray into cracks, crevices, and other surface areas as specified in label directions.


There is no need for further dilution. This product is intended for use in buildings, offices, restaurants, households and other similar areas and outdoors as a spot treatment to house foundation walls and around windows and doors for the control of those pests specified on this label.

Precautions: 1) Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, or wall coverings, and fabrics. 2) When used in dwellings, care should be taken to avoid deposits which could be frequently contacted by children. 3) Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before spraying. 4) Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until surfaces are dry. 5) Do not use as a space spray. 6) Do not spray on pets or plants. 7) Do not contaminate food, food containers, or cooking utensils. 8) Avoid excessive application to carpets. 9) DO NOT use this product in conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, Silverfish: Make spot applications to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and similar areas where these insects hide. Spray areas until wet. Repeat application as necessary to maintain control.



Carpet beetles: Spray in spot applications along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting and rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Avoid excessive wetting of carpets.

Spiders and Scorpions: Spray around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl.


Pantry Pests--Exposed Stages (Sawtoothed grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle, Indian meal moth): Spray on shelves and in cupboards where food containers suspected of being infested are stored. Remove all food and shelving paper before spraying. Do not replace the food packages until spray has dried. Cover shelves with shelving paper. This treatment is supplemental to good housekeeping, since it will have no effect on insects breeding within food packages. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

Brown dog ticks, fleas*: Apply thoroughly to infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets, and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this product. Repeat as necessary. Avoid excessive wetting of floor coverings, rugs or unfinished material, since damage may occur. Do not apply directly to upholstery. Do not use as an overall space spray.

*Controls adult fleas on areas treated.

Food and Feed Handling Establishments (including places other than private residences in which exposed food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served.)

(Spray either as a crack and crevice or spot treatment as directed below. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will come in contact with food. Take extreme care to avoid contamination of food or food contact surfaces and to avoid introducing the material into the air.



Food/Feed Areas of Food and Feed Handling Establishments
(Application limited to Crack and Crevice and Spot Treatments
Only)

Food/Feed areas include areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage, and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation are considered a food area) and includes facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Crack and Crevice Treatment - As a crack and crevice treatment, spray a pin stream in small amounts directly into such spaces as expansion joints, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, wall boards, baseboards or openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, hollow equipment legs and bases where cockroaches (waterbugs), ants, spiders, and silverfish hide.

Spot Treatment - As a spot treatment, spray on selective floor surfaces, in areas around water pipes, beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, storage areas, baseboards, under elements of constructions and similar areas where cockroaches, ants, spiders, and silverfish hide.

Limit spot treatments to floor surfaces where pests have been seen or where they are suspected of hiding. Limit spot treatments to an area no larger than 20 percent of the floor surface. Any individual spot treatment shall not exceed two square feet.

Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

These treatments also aid in the control of pantry pests (exposed stages of saw-toothed grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle, and Indian meal moth) which come into contact with treated surfaces. DO NOT use this product in conduits, motor housings, and electrical switch boxes. Repeat application as necessary.

Application of this product in the food/feed areas of food or feed handling establishments other than as crack, and crevice and spot treatments are not permitted.

Nonfood/Feed Areas of Food and Feed Handling Establishments

Nonfood/Feed areas include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

In nonfood/feed areas, apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, on surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets, and on similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

House Foundation Treatment

This product will control ants, boxelder bugs, brown dog ticks, chiggers, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, fleas, flies, millipedes, sowbugs, spiders, and collembola (spring-tails) which are commonly found near the house and may enter the house. Apply as a spot treatment to house foundation walls and around doors and windows where these pests are likely to enter. Repeat application as necessary. Do not spray desirable plants and shrubbery because injury may occur.

Storage and Disposal

Keep from freezing. Store above 32°F. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.
