If in eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention promptly.

If swallowed: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING as vomiting may present aspiration hazard. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and get medical help. If no other treatment is available, induce vomiting only under medical supervision. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
