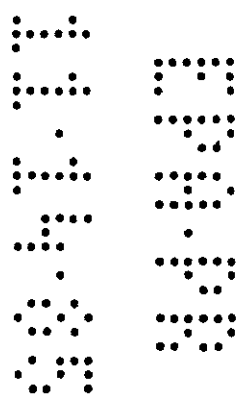
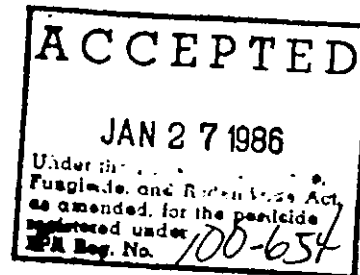

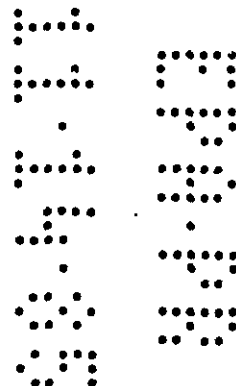

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR USE AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS LABEL MAY RESULT IN CROP INJURY AND/OR POOR INSECT CONTROL.

Trigard is a 75% wettable powder which, when mixed with water according to the directions for use given below, will control certain insect species on designated plants.

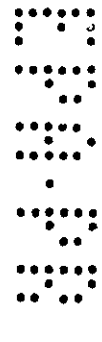
Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons, except those knowingly involved in the application. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Reentry Statement

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until seven days after last application.

Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. Oral warnings must be given which inform workers of areas or fields that may not be entered without specific protective clothing until seven days after last application and appropriate actions to take in case of accidental exposure as described under Precautionary Statements on this label. When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. Written warnings must include the following information: "CAUTION. Area treated with Trigard 75W on (date of application). Do not enter without appropriate protective clothing until seven days after last application. In case of accidental exposure, flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."



Mixing Instructions

Prepare no more spray mixture than is needed for the immediate operation. Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using this product. Agitate thoroughly before and during application. Good bypass agitation is sufficient to keep Trigard 75W thoroughly mixed. Flush spray tank thoroughly with water daily after use and dispose of pesticide rinsate by application to an already treated area.

Trigard 75W Alone: Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of unopened soluble bags of Trigard 75W into the tank. (One 2-lb. water-soluble bag of Trigard 75W will treat 12 acres of celery or lettuce.) Continue agitation while adding the remainder of the water.

Note: Do not let spray mixture stand overnight in the spray tank. Rinse spray tank at the end of the day.

To avoid spray drift, do not apply under windy conditions. Avoid spray overlap, as crop injury may result.

Celery and Lettuce (Head Only)

For leafminer control, apply 1/6 lb. Trigard 75W per acre as a foliar spray in a minimum of 5 gals. of water by air as leafminers first appear. Repeat applications at 7-day intervals or as necessary to maintain control.

Notes: 1) Do not make more than 12 applications to one crop of celery or 8 applications to one crop of lettuce, and 2) Do not make the last application within 7 days of harvest, or illegal residues may result.

Rotational Crops

All crops on this label may be planted following harvest of a Trigard 75W-treated crop. Do not rotate to any other crop, except sweet corn or radishes. Do not plant sweet corn or radishes within 3 months after last application.

Storage and Disposal

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use in animal feeds.

Storage - Do not store this product under wet conditions. Handle outer bag carefully when stored at temperatures less than 50°F to avoid breakage of inner soluble bag.

Pesticide Disposal - Improper disposal of unused pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions, must be disposed of according to federal, state or local procedures. For guidance in proper disposal methods, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office.

Container Disposal - Do not reuse outer bag. Dispose of empty outer bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

For minor spills, leaks, etc., follow all precautions indicated on this label and clean up immediately. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during cleanup procedures and disposal of wastes.
